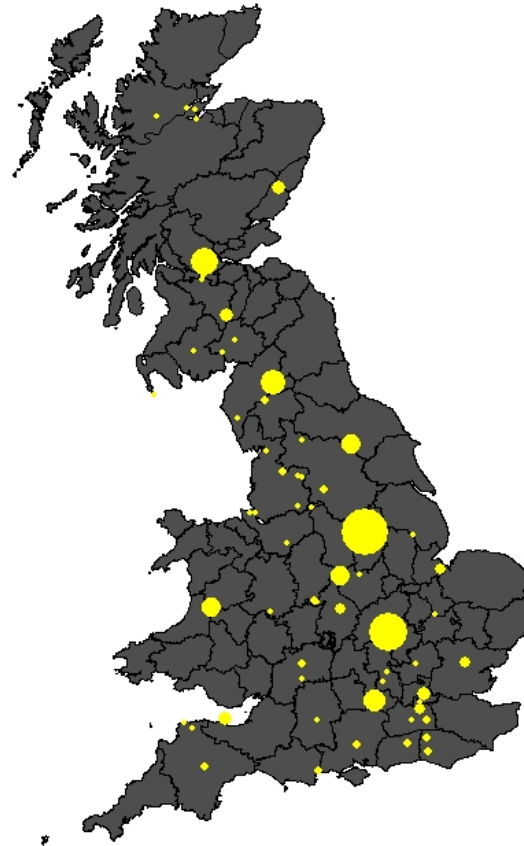

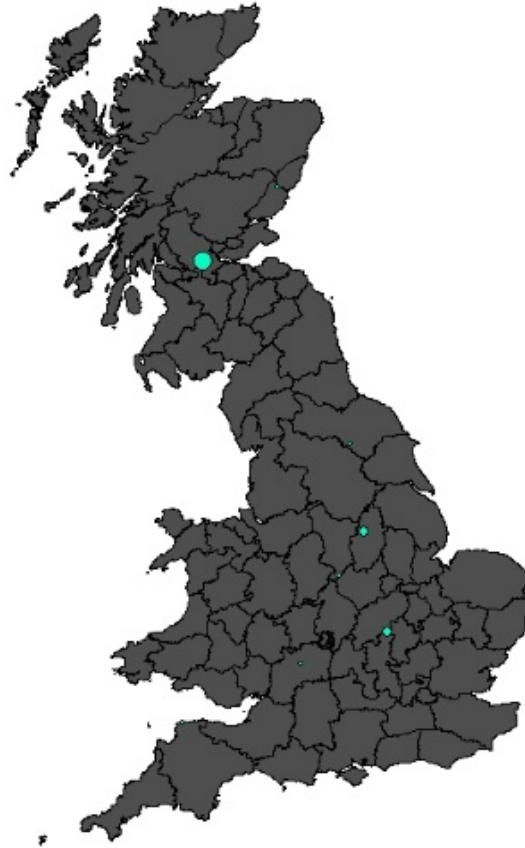

Placenames related to drought events



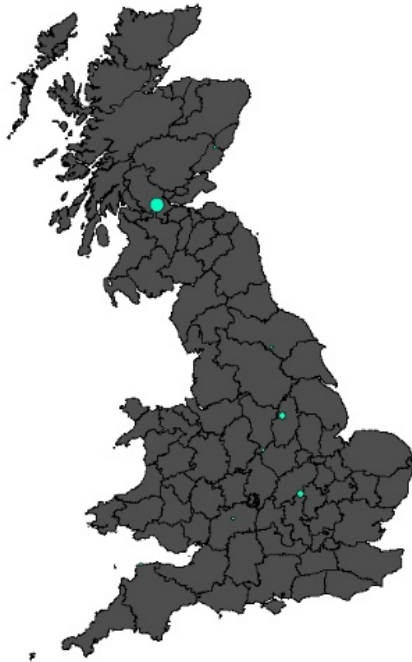

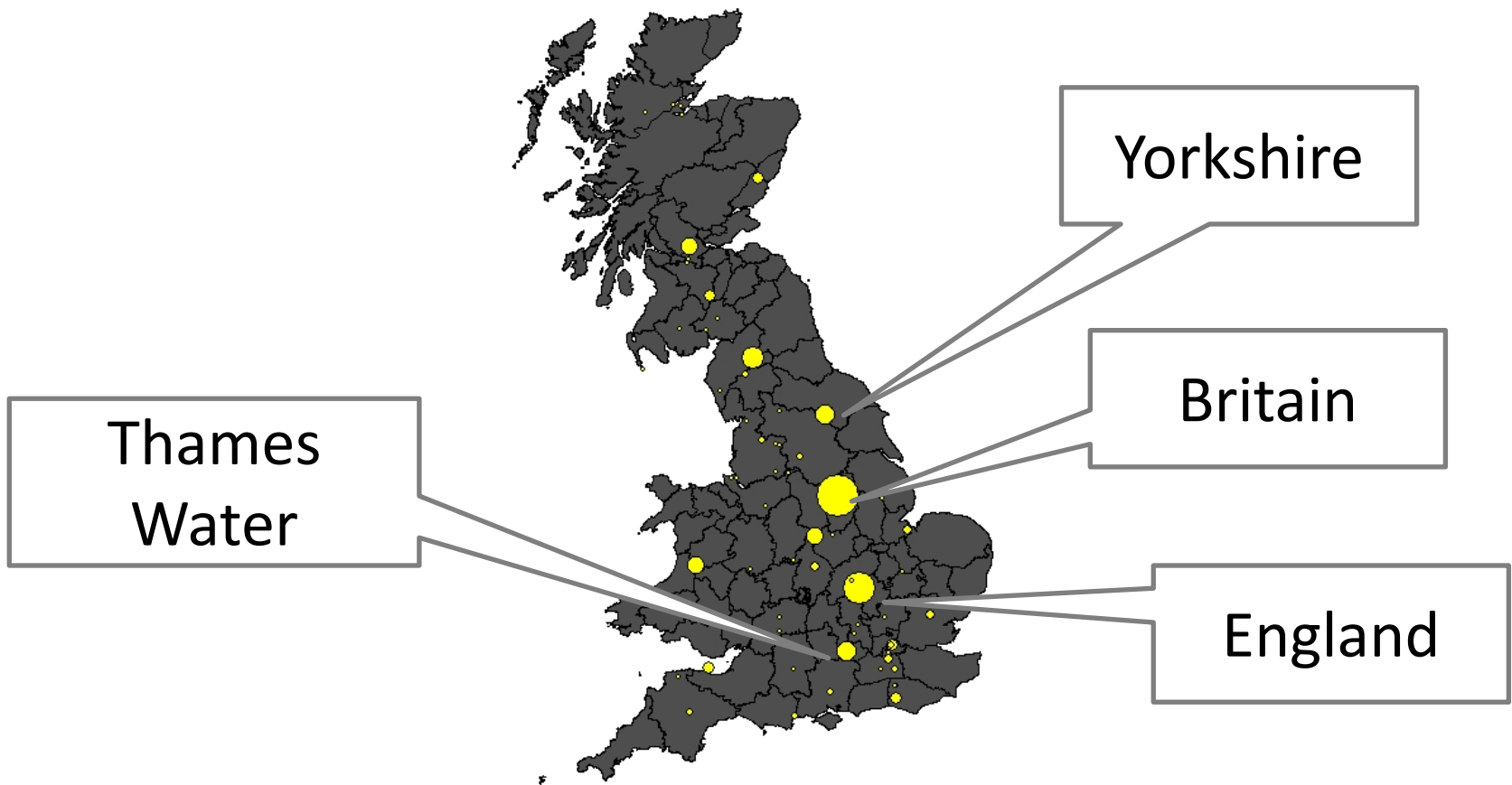

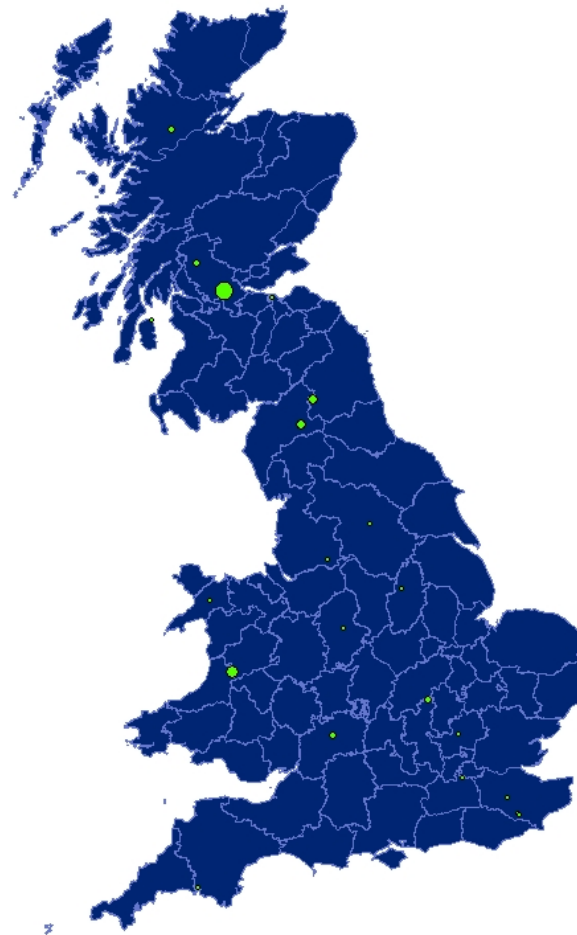

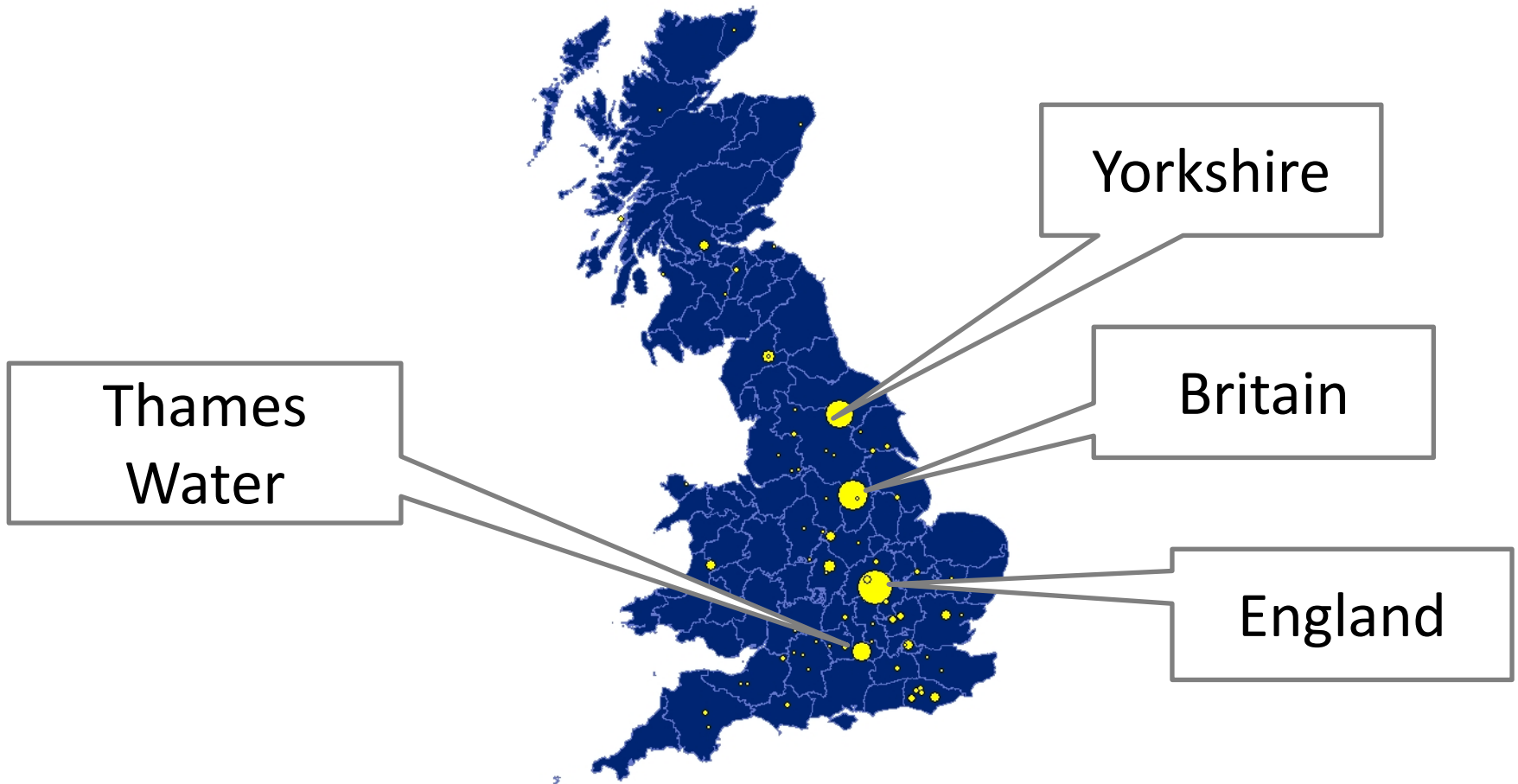
Places with NO drought
